<b>Requirements: /</b>			
<b>Aims of the course:</b> Although students already have a basis in human rights law, the course shall enable them to deepend it and interconnect it with other fields of law.			
<b>Course result:</b> Due to the fact that students are initiated in the human rights law within other law disciplines, the course main aim is to offer constitutional law approach to this important topic, combining it with the wider, international law perspective. The course shall enable students to deepen their knowledge and to create more complete idea of human rights.			
<b>Course content:</b> Two aspects of the internal (constitutional) aspect of human rights will be studied: general (notion and subject matter, legal sources, improvement and control of human rights, monitoring the implementation of human rights as well as the types of this supervision and activities of the entities involved in the supervision procedure); and, particular (fundamental human rights which are enshrined in the international instruments and which are incorporated, or should be, in the Serbian legal system).
