Aims of the course:

The aim is to provide students with theoretical knowledge in the field of political system. The focus is on the general theoretical problems of the science of politics and the political system, as well as the principles and institute of contemporary political systems. The task of the course is to highlight the most important aspects of the theory and practice of the political system that are relevant to the liberal-democratic constitution of Serbia. The particular task of the course is developing the candidate's ability for independent scientific analysis, application of research methods and formulation of attitudes and arguments in this field.

Course result:

The candidates are expected to independently formulate the problem that is the subject of scientific and analytical processing, define and conduct research, and present the results of the research in different scientific forms.
