Aims of the course: The aim of the course is that students expand and deepen their knowledge on Sociology of Law **Course result:** Students should acquire a higher level of knowledge and master skills that enable them to critically discuss the issues of sociology of law, as well as their ability to undertake their first scientific researches.

Course content: includes both key and current problems of sociology of law and the basis of methodology of social sciences:

- the emergence of sociology of law, its basic theoretical-epistemological and methodological-research problems and contemporary trends;
- problems of social action and normative orientation of human behavior;
- the principles of scientific knowledge and problems of methodology of social sciences;
- social processes and problems of their legal regulation;
- processes of human and socio-economic reproduction and problems of their legal regulation (labor and division of labor; production and law; property; legal aspects of population problems);
- social relations in marriage and family; relations between gender and generations and problems of their normative regulation;
- relation of the social structure and the legal system;
- ethnic relations and ethnic rules;
- legal regulation of social inequalities;
- relation of social institutions, organizations and the law;
- relation of culture and the law and problems of legal culture;
- relation of the law and other social norms (morality and customs);
- factors of social development and problems of reception and law enforcement;
- social risks and the legal challenges of globalization and the emergence of new forms of the law in contemporary societies.
