Outline of the course – 1. Commercial and non-commercial legal entities; 2. Common legal rules for companies; 3. Societies with unlimited risk (partnerships) – partnership, limited/special partnership, limited partnership with shares, unlimited companies in anglo-saxon practice, silent partnership, company by estoppel and de facto company; 4. Societies with limited risk (companies) – private limited company (limited liability company), guarantee company in anglo-saxon practice, limited liability partnerships in anglo-saxon practice; 5. Societies with limited risk (companies) – company limited by shares, shares and other securities, re-organisation of capital and shares, shareholders, minority shareholders, dividing powers within a company (Company's organs), some special concepts of public company limited by shares; 6. Specialised companies limited by shares; 7. Enterprises – subjects of privatization (public – state owned enterprises); 8. Transformation of companies; 9. Groups of companies; 10. Status changes; 11. Commercial associations; 12. Winding up and dissolution of partnerships and companies; 13. Companies regulated by EU law.
