<b>Course content:</b> Political background of the codification undertaking and genesis of Dušan's Code; <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. conceptual bases of the legislative undertaking;</li> <li>2. the structure of Dušan's legislation;</li> <li>3. reception of Byzantine law in medieval Serbia;</li> <li>4. tradition of Byzantine law in territories belonging to the Nemanjić state;</li> <li>5. complementarity of norms of the Abbreviated Syntagma of Blastares and of Dušan's Code;</li> <li>6. origin of normative content encompassed in Dušan's Code;</li> <li>7. the concept of statute seen through glass of Serbian medieval sources and the concept of legality in Dušan's Code;</li> <li>8. the genesis of most important legal mechanisms in certain areas of law (ecclesiastical, civil, criminal, public and judicial law);</li> </ol> Dušan's Code following the demise of the Serbian medieval state.
