## **Requirements:**

Aims of the course: Study of this subject improves the ability of students to integrate knowledge, solve complex problems and to exercise judgment based on the available information that contain reflections on social and ethical responsibilities linked to the application of their knowledge and judgments. Study of terrorism at universities is now necessary to develop and build strategies to combat it, or reducing the risk of it in the society and in the international community. As for the modernity of this study, it is enough to mention that today countries that qualify as modern science states are those that in higher education programs have incorporated the study of terrorism and of mechanisms to combat it.

**Course result:** Acquiring in-depth knowledge and critical thinking skills in the field of fight against organized crime and terrorism.

Course content: Crime as a phenomenon. The conceptualization of the term "organized crime". Background and state of organized crime in some countries. Transnational organized crime. Activities of organized crime. Combating organized crime. Differentiating terrorism from other forms of political violence; Conceptualization of the term "terrorist". A Brief History of terrorism, and its presence in some regions or countries; Classification of types and forms of terrorism, according to the strategic objectives; Ideological terrorism; Religiously founded terrorism; The ethno-nationalist terrorism; Classifying the type and form of terrorism according to methods and means; Suicide terrorism; Combating terrorism in the world - the experience of individual countries; International efforts at combating terrorism; Combating terrorism in Serbia.
