Aims of the course: The aim of the subject The policy of suppressing organized crime, terrorism and corruption is the study of the criminal-legal reaction to the aforementioned serious forms of crime, i.e. criminal legislation that should be an adequate response to it. Estimating the extent of these forms of behavior indicate that terrorism, a set of various crimes committed by members of organized criminal associations and corruption, is one of the most serious problems of the modern state.			
Course result: Acquiring knowledge necessary for understanding and critical analysis of the criminal law enforcement of organized crime in its various manifestations.			
Course content: Criminal law and criminal law protection. Criminal sanctions and other criminal-law measures. Criminal law response to terrorism. Criminal law response to organized crime. Criminal law reaction to corruption.
