Course Title: THE LAW OF BANKRUPTCY

Aim of the course: Gaining in-depth knowledge in the field of bankruptcy law; recognizing the reasons behind the adoption and implementation of specific rules; understanding the policy and the goals that drive bankruptcy regulation in a certain direction; learning about possible means to achieve these goals; understanding the necessity and the benefits of establishing effective bankruptcy procedure; studying bankruptcy legal framework in the EU law and its comparison to the Serbian law; developing an awareness of the importance of bankruptcy for the overall economy; underlining the need to implement in practice the knowledge gained at this course.

Learning outcome – Student acquires in-depth, fundamental knowledge as well as capability to critically analyze the field of bankruptcy law, as well as competences necessary for applying acquired knowledge in practice. This course is aimed at providing an analysis of national, comparative and international legal rules, that regulate bankruptcy law.
