Requirements:

Aims of the course: Complementing the existing theoretical knowledge, comprehensively reviewing the criminal law system, critical and analytical consideration of positive legal solutions and multifunctional linking of the theoretical and practical aspects of the study.

Course result: Training students to analyze existing solutions to national material and procedural criminal law, as well as training them for the application of these solutions in practice.

Course content: As students have basic knowledge in this field, the emphasis will be on a more detailed theoretical analysis of legal and procedural institutes and dilemmas in the practical application of legal solutions. The recent reforms in criminal legislation, with emphasis on the practical application of the newly adopted solutions, are also addressed.

Substantive law: Analysis of individual solutions contained in the Law on Amendments to the Criminal Code from 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2016; Characteristics of newly introduced criminal offences; Justification of the intensification of criminal repression; Perspectives of Criminal Legislation of Serbia.

Procedural law: Criminal procedural principles and changes within these principles; The position and powers of the subjects in the criminal procedure; Characteristics and the course of the general criminal procedure; Special procedures; Reforms of procedural legislation.
