Aims of the course: The main objectives of the course are: 1) to acquire knowledge of the judicial review of constitutionality; 2) to understand the complex nature of this function; 3) to qualify for legal analysis of constitutional courts' decisions; 4) to analyze the jurisprudence of the Constitutional Court of Serbia as well as the comparative jurisprudence.			
Course result: Acquiring knowledge and skills that enable: an independent and critical thinking about various topics concerned judicial review of constitutionality; conducting an autonomous and original research; writing master thesis after conducted research.			
Course content: Dealing with theoretical, comparative and positive law aspects of judicial review of constitutionality. The course is devoted to: studying the nature of this complex state function; analyzing the selection process and the composition of constitutional courts as well as the procedure of constitutional review and the effects of decisions of constitutional courts. Special attention is paid to the practice of the Constitutional Court of Serbia.
