<b>Aim of the course:</b> Learning the basic sector specific rules regarding bankruptcy law; recognizing the reasons behind the adoption and implementation of specific rules; understanding the policy and the goals that drive bankruptcy regulation in a certain direction; learning about possible means to achieve these goals; understanding the necessity and the benefits of establishing effective bankruptcy procedure; studying bankruptcy legal framework in the EU law and its comparison to the Serbian law; developing an awareness of the importance of bankruptcy for the overall economy; underlining the need to implement in practice the knowledge gained at this course.			
<b>Learning outcome:</b> Students will gain basic knowledge about bankruptcy law, learn the basic legal terminology and develop a critical way of thinking about bankruptcy law issues.
