## Aims of the course:

- Acquiring practical knowledge and skills necessary for future work
- Application of law in real situations
- Solving concrete problems in business and judicial practice
- Familiarization with the functioning of legal institutions
- Introduction with the duties and responsibilities of a lawyer at his workplace

#### **Course result:**

The course should provide students with the knowledge and skills necessary for performing legal profession in the judiciary and administration

## **Course content:**

Phase One:

The student performs a practice in a period of four weeks, four hours a day. Depending on where practice is practiced, it is possible to organize a practice differently with the same number of classes / for example full time every second day/. During the practice, the student become familiar with legal jobs that are performed in a specific workplace, observes lawyers doing these jobs and performs by himself simpler legal tasks under the supervision of an employee.

Phase two:

The student on class briefly describes his activities during the practice. He presents the content of the legal act that he made, explains the facts of the case and substantive and procedural norms that have been applied and answers possible questions regarding the act.
