Course Title: INSURANCE LAW

Professors: Prof. Dr. Nataša Petrović Tomić **Status:** mandatory for Business Law stream

Number of ECTS: 3

Requirements: Bachelor degree

Aims of the course: The course aims at providing students with basic knowledge and understanding of the Insurance law as the branch of law, with detailed studying of especially important legal issues in the business of insurance; understanding the essence of contract of insurance, in order to enable students to apply the acquired knowledge in practice when concluding a contract of insurance as well as when executing it; practical work with students on making contracts and policies; introduction into the regime of international sources and tendencies in insurance law; encouraging critical thinking about the existing solutions in positive insurance law; introduction into comparative insurance law and insurance law of European Union.

Course result: Students will acquire knowlegde and the skills of interpreting as well as of critical analysis of insurance law provisions. By successfully mastering the course students will be able to deal with legal affairs in insurance companies, National Bank of Serbia and other institutions dealing with the business of insurance.

Course content: 1. Role and importance of insurance, notion and definition of insurance; 2. Sources of insurance law; 3. Terms of insurance: risk, insurance premium, insurance amount, insurance casualty; 4. Divisions of insurance: by nature of risk, by subject matter of the contract, according to the way of creation, according to the method of equalization of risk, according to the way of organization and according to the number od persons insured; 5. Insurance companies; 6. Brokers of insurance; 7. Conclusion of insurance contract; 8. Duties of contracting parties; 9. Insurance for third party account; 10. Cumulation of insurance and civil liability; 11. Property insurance; 12. Liability insurance; 13. Insurance against civil liability in respect of the use of motor vehicles; 14. Insurance of persons; 15. Reinsurance.
