 - 6.2. Procedural discretion
 - 6.3. Principle of urgency
 - 6.4. Discretion of criminal prosecution of juveniles
- 7. Actors in criminal proceedings against juveniles
- 8. The first instance proceedings against juveniles;
- 9. Legal remedies in the juvenile procedure;
- 10. Harmonization of the juvenile proceedings with the relevant international documents.
