Aims of the course:

The aim of the course is to expend the knowledge of issues in the field of cooperative law, as well as the right of non-profit organizations, with which students have only been introduced to a certain extent during course of general part of Civil Law and Company Law. It is a positive law course in legal studies where students can gain knowledge of the origin of cooperatives and non-profit organizations, their historical development, comparative law and positive regulation of the way of establishment, functioning and objectives of cooperatives and non-profit organizations. The aim of the course is to enable students interested to their legal profession, through comprehensive education, to deal with the problems of these specific types of legal entities, enable the legislative, theoretical and practical issues in this field.

Course result:

Training students for analysis of existing solutions of national law, as well as training for implementation of this solutions in practice.
