Aims of the course: Acquiring knowledge in the field of succession law; mastering legal terminology and methodology of succession law; development of capacities for analytical and critical thinking; improvement of practical skills; development of professional ethics, learning about professional responsibility.

Course result: Students will acquire knowledge necessary for analysis and application of succession law, as well as the capacity to critically evaluate solutions in positive succession law.

Course content: 1. Institution of succession, succession law, sources and basic principles of succession law; 2. Prerequisites for succession; 3. Succession of decedent's blood relatives. Succession law consequences of adoption; 4. Succession of decedent's spouse. State as the heir; 5. Freedom of testation and forced shares. Exclusion of heirs; 6. Methods of satisfying forced shares and the protection of forced shares; 7. Notion, legal nature and contents of a will; 8. Interpretation of wills. Testamentary forms; 9. Witnesses in the law of wills. Safekeeping of a will; 10. Revocation of a will. Nullity of a will; 11. Contracts in succession law – Contract of distribution of property, Life care contract. Community of heirs; 12. Probate proceedings; 13. Computation of gifts and bequests in the inheritance share; 14. Infringement of forced shares; 15. Liability of universal and singular successors for decedent's debts.
